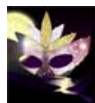

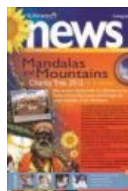
[Sunflower Supporters](#)

Did you know that in the UK alone over 2 million printer cartridges are disposed of in landfill sites and 15 million unwanted mobile phones are similarly discarded?



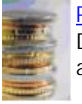
[Leaving a Legacy of Living](#)
