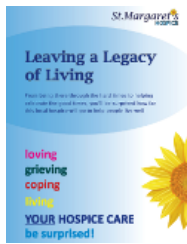


## Leaving a Legacy of Living

- Pecuniary Legacy
- Residuary Legacy
- Specific Legacy
